- 1. Samhain**
(Pronounced “Sow-en”). October 31, November 1. Halloween, Hallowmass, Hallow’s Eve, All Soul’s Day. Considered High Holy Day
Third Harvest Festival
- 2. Yule**
Winter Solstice, December 21
Longest Night
- 3. Imbolg/Brighid**
February 1, 2
Fire Festival, Cross Quarter Day
- 4. Spring Equinox/Ostara**
Easter, Estre, Oestre
Equal Night/Equal Day
March 21
- 5. Beltaine**
(Pronounced “Bell-tane”). Mayday. May 1
Fire Festival, High Holy Day
- 6. Litha**
Summer Solstice/Midsummer, June 21
Longest Day
- 7. Lammas**
Lughnasadh, Loafmas August 1, Cross Quarter Day
First Harvest Festival
- 8. Mabon**
Fall or Vernal Equinox, September 21
Second Harvest Festival
Equal Night/Equal Day
